

IMPORTANT ASPECT

1 Peter 1:15-17

"**15** but as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, **16** since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy."

- How is holiness expressed in people?
- What should our way of life be like? What are some practical examples?
- What does this passage of scripture challenge you to do?
- How does this theme affect God's children?
